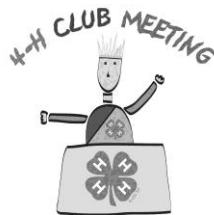
4-H in Lawrence Township!!

Lawrence Township 4-H is a year-round program, culminating with the Lawrence Township 4-H Fair and the Marion County 4-H Fair in June and the Indiana State Fair in August. During the year (September to June), 4-H members participate in community service projects, attend monthly meetings and develop new skills by working independently on their choice of over 60 different projects offered by Purdue Extension - Marion County 4-H Youth Development.

Most projects have manuals with valuable learning information and instructions for properly completing the project. There is a nominal charge for manuals.

Information for the many different county activities and opportunities for the 4-Her, along with the guidelines for each project and requirements necessary for exhibiting completed projects at the county fair is available online at extension.purdue.edu/Marion.

Enroll for the 2017-18 4-H year online at extension.purdue.edu/Marion beginning Oct 1, 2017. There is a \$15 state fee to join for grades 3-12. *Scholarships are available as needed.* There is NO fee for Minis (K-2).



Lawrence Township 4-H Club meetings are held monthly during the school year in the Amy

Beverland Elementary (ABE) cafeteria (11650 Fox Road), generally on the 2nd Monday of the month*. Club leader Bev Fudge and Mini Club Leader Jamie Neal help the 4-H members lead meetings, plan events and gain such skills as working with each other in simple demonstrations and speaking before the group. Club meetings consist of a mixer, business meeting led by club officers, informative program, and recreation. The meetings are intended to be both fun and educational and are held from 6:15 pm to 7:30 pm. September - May meetings meet at Amy Beverland.
